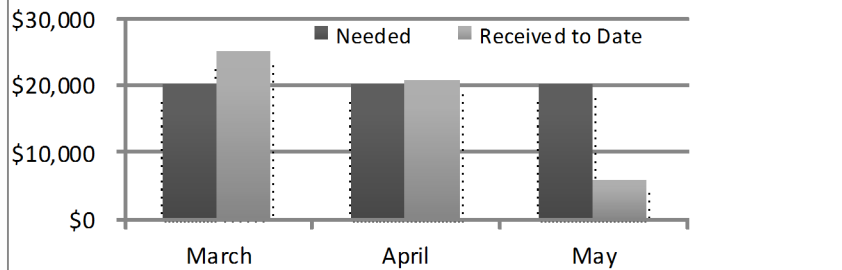


Giving is Worship
