Alterations - If anyone has experience with alterations we could use your help. Please contact the church office if you are willing to give a little time.


Locking up doors and gates: Deacons or Elders, if you are closing up please be sure that all doors, gates and access points are securely shut and locked with the alarm set.

commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus."


