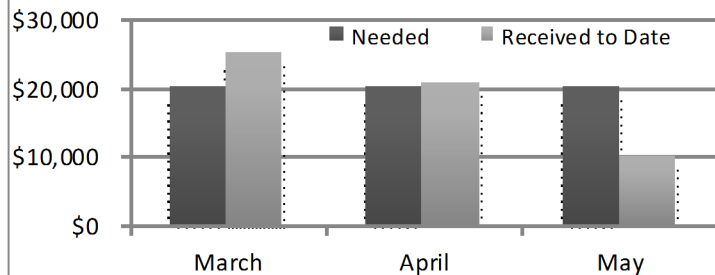


Giving is Worship

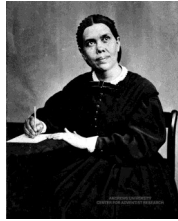
Please come on time.
