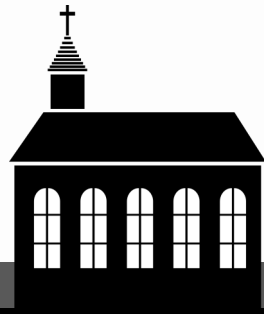

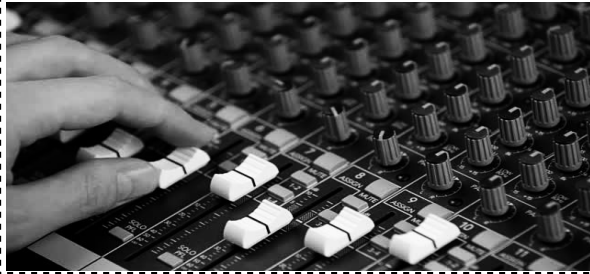

Please join us for Wednesday Prayer Meeting where we are discussing the names of God.

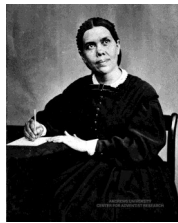
